



Property Alert-Background

• Property is usually the most valuable asset people own. It can be sold and mortgaged to raise money and can therefore be an attractive target for fraudsters.

• As well as financial loss, a fraudulent property transaction also creates emotional distress for home owners and prospective buyers.

• Those seeking to carry out fraud may seek to impersonate anyone in a conveyancing transaction, including owners, buyers, sellers, borrowers, lenders or conveyancers.

Property Alert-Background Property Registration Authority

 The PRA has always been aware of the possibility of property fraud and works internally and with other Land Registry organisations to monitor developments and develop safeguards. It is accepted that property fraud is now a real threat in Ireland.

• Evidence from similar jurisdictions indicates that property fraud, though generally beginning with small-scale attempts at fraud through personal applications, has the potential to quickly evolve into wide-scale attempts at property fraud that involve identity theft.

Property Alert System



A key action arising out of the Counter Fraud Strategy, the system will allow

citizens to:

- 1. sign up to the alert service online;
- 2. set up and manage alerts on registered property;
- 3. monitor any property up to a limit of three;
- 4. obtain email and SMS alerts when an application for registration is lodged on a property being monitored; and
- 5. receive relevant information on the application.


